

NJB Fall League II Rule Exceptions

The Fall League II plays under Newburgh Junior Baseball Rules with the following exceptions:

Time Limitation

No inning will begin one hour and forty-five minutes after the start of the game. The game will be called two hours after the starting time of the game. The starting time of the first game of the day is the scheduled starting time.

There is no infield practice before the games because of time limitation.

No extra innings will be played.

Courtesy Runner

A courtesy runner may replace the next catcher as a base runner when there are two outs. The courtesy runner will be the player who made the last out on the roster.

Run Limit

The offensive team is limited to five runs per inning except in the last inning.

Run Rule

The game will be considered a complete game if one team is ahead by fifteen runs or more after four innings (three and one-half innings if the Home team is ahead). If time remains the teams may continue to play until the one hour and forty-five minute time limit is reached.

Forfeits

There are no forfeits in NJB Fall Baseball. An out is not recorded in the batting line up if a team must play with less than nine players or for players who leave after the start of the game.

Batting

Teams will bat the entire roster. Players pulled from another team (pullovers) must bat last in the batting roster. Players arriving late to the game will be added to the end of the batting roster as they arrive.

Team Defense

There is free substitution defensively; however, all players must not sit out two consecutive innings. Players pulled from another team (pullovers) may not be used as a pitcher or catcher.

Pitching

A player may pitch two innings per game.

A pitcher removed from the mound during the game cannot return as a pitcher.

No breaking pitches are allowed. Penalty: the pitch shall be called a ball unless the batter reaches first base and no other runner is put out before advancing at least one base.

Base Stealing

No base stealing is allowed until the fourth game for both teams.

Point of Emphasis - Infield Fly Rule

The infield fly rule is in effect for League II.
